

About Energy Saving Scotland home renewables grants

If you own your home and want to be more self-sufficient, then a grant could help to bring your plans to life.

The Energy Saving Scotland home renewables scheme is managed by the Energy Saving Trust in Scotland on behalf of the Scottish Government.

Grants of 30% (up to £4,000) of the total cost of products and installation are available.

There are different types of renewable energy available, and those covered by the scheme are:

- Wind turbines
- Micro-hydro turbines
- Solar water and space heating
- Solar Photovoltaic - solar electricity
- Ground, air and water source heat pumps
- Wood fuel boilers and stoves (non-automated feed stoves are not covered as they are a well established technology)
- Connections to the Lerwick District Heating System.
