

Fuel Poverty Grants

Hjaltland Housing Association operates a One Stop Shop in partnership with the Shetland Islands Council to provide advice and information for private sector properties. Grant funding is available to households who are in Fuel Poverty to carry out a range of improvements (which include connection to the district heating scheme) to reduce their fuel poverty status. Fuel Poverty occurs when a household spends more than 10% of its income on household fuel costs.
